DESCRIPTION OF POSITION

Position Title: Video Intern

Summary: Be a part of WiLDCOAST's latest campaign to defeat pollution at the US-Mexico border by documenting contamination sources and creating short informational films. The films will play an integral part in our campaign to ensure that our beaches and ocean are clean for future generations.

Supervisor: Ben McCue, Coastal Conservation Program Manager

Goal of Position: Produce videos for distribution to popular websites and to media and policy makers to increase awareness of the health risks posed by pollution and the need for a comprehensive clean water plan.

Sample of Specific Tasks:

1. Identify locales for filming along with Program Manager
2. Create record of contamination via film
3. Edit film to create videos for distribution

Location/Worksite: South San Diego County (WiLDCOAST office) and throughout Tijuana River Watershed; including beaches, *maquiladoras* (sweat shops), *colonias* (ghettos), and agricultural areas.
